



For: Reiki Teachers Applying to the C.R.A. as a New Registered Teacher

To qualify as a C.R.A. Registered Teacher and you have not been a member of the C.R.A., the applicant will have studied and successfully completed the minimum teaching requirements for the style of Reiki they studied. This will consist of not less than three (3) up to four (4) levels of training depending on Lineage. We encourage all applicants to teach Reiki classes during this one year waiting period.

To apply for New Registered Teacher Membership please submit the following documents:

- Upon the **one year anniversary** of receiving your Master Level Certificate you may apply
- Signed and fully completed **Registered Teacher Membership Form**
- Submit your **original** class outlines in theory and practical for each level of Reiki you were attuned for in the Master Class. **Each level** will be reviewed by the C.R.A. Board. Photocopies of other Reiki Teachers outlines will **not** be accepted. **All levels** must be submitted regardless if you are teaching them at the present time.
- Photo copies of all your Reiki certificates
- Signed **Code of Ethics Form**
- Signed **Disciplinary Action Form**
- Signed **Code of Conduct Form**
- Signed **Scope of Practice Form**
- Signed **C.R.A. Teachers Educational Guidelines Form**
- Complete **twenty-four (24) case studies and submit** with your application
- Case studies must be recorded on **CRA Case Study Forms**.
- One sixty (60) minute Reiki Session equals one case study. Sessions longer than 60 minutes will only equal one case study. You must have at **least 3 different clients** when doing your case studies.
- Case studies can be combined with C.E.U.'s signed by a CRA Reiki Teacher hosting a Reiki Exchange or a Student Practice Night on **CRA CEU Forms**
- Case studies must equal twenty-four hours
- If you include Continuing Education Units forms C.E.U. they may not exceed half or twelve (12) of the 24 case studies minimum. (This is optional)
- Practice time at CRA Teacher hosted practices and CRA hosted Reiki exchanges will count as **1 CEU per one contact hour for a maximum of 2 CEU's per event**.
- Case studies will not consist of Distance Reiki, practicing on animals or on children
- Case studies must be completed within the twelve months before the date of your application
- Cheque or money order made out to The Canadian Reiki Association

If payment was made online please enclose the PayPal invoice. To avoid delay ensure that all documents have been signed and enclosed with your membership application
